Paul is an adjunct professor at the University of Toronto, where he teaches media law. He is currently serving his third term as an elected bencher of The Law Society of Upper Canada, the governing body for Ontario's 50,000 lawyers. He is chair of the Law Foundation of Ontario and a director of the Canadian Civil Liberties Association, The Osgoode Society for Canadian Legal History and the Canadian Journalism Foundation. He is a past president of the Canadian Media Lawyers Association and of Pro Bono Law Ontario.
